


City of Pewaukee at a glance

- The population of the City of Pewaukee is 13,942 (2014 US Census).
- Approximately 3,883 families reside in the City of Pewaukee with an estimated 5,451 total occupied homes.
- The City of Pewaukee is home to approximately 2,044 businesses.
- The City of Pewaukee is a municipal entity with a Mayor and Common Council form of government.
- City of Pewaukee is approximately 21.8 square miles.
- Main thoroughfares include STH 16, I-94, STH 164 and STH 190.

NEW to the Fleet



SQUAD 245

As a means to augment current squads that were incurring higher mileage rotations. Increased activity and traffic saturations facilitated by grant monies, the Common Council was approached to purchase an addition squad. Squad 245 was added to the fleet in 2015.



ALPRS (City of Pewaukee squad 249)

Automatic License Plate Recognition Systems allow agencies to patrol high traffic/crime areas while acquiring large volumes of local vehicle data. When combined with associated software, ALPRS can be used to associate vehicles with efforts related to crime scene investigation, criminal travel patterns and hotspots and numerous other intelligence purposes. The City of Pewaukee was chosen for one of these units do to the high volume of activity. Mobile ALPR Camera systems provide high resolution coverage of a full lane of traffic with up to two concurrent vehicles in the field of view. The sleek designs mount nicely below the light bar for limited visual interference.

CVS Drop Box



Since installation of the CVS Drug Box late in 2014, the Waukesha Sheriff's ID Bureau has completed periodic collections. The collections are weighed and inventoried for tracking and later transported to an alternate site for proper destruction. The CVS box is located inside the main entrance to the Pewaukee Substation. In 2015 this site collected **166 pounds** of prescription drugs.


Through Badges & Buddies, we strive to create a positive learning experience while fishing, bowling and shooting archery. In a controlled setting, deputies guide the children in safe use of equipment and educate them about the importance and benefit of conservation as a tool to promote the health of our resources and wildlife. Deputies also spend time having lunch with the children and then provide a gift bag donated by sponsors which contains educational material and outdoor related items.

The program continues to partner with local businesses. These partnerships while benefiting the program have a secondary impact of creating working relationships with Pewaukee businesses. Deputies utilize this time to discuss and answer questions about police services within the City of Pewaukee, offering personalized service as needed.

The Waukesha County Citizen's Academy has become an integral part of the program, volunteering their time picking up and cooking lunches for the programs. Adam Thompson, a citizen volunteer has donated countless hours to the programs.

The cooperative effort of ALL involved, directly impacts the program success allowing us to maintain a quality experience by providing equipment, t-shirts for the participants, cover facility rental fees, staff, and provide food/beverages for the children. In 2015, our programs were attended by approximately **322 children**.

This year the Badges & Buddies Picnic was the largest ever hosted with over **300 attendees**. A great time was had by all. Our special guests were the return of Pewaukee's Army Reserve Unit and Flight for Life. We also enjoyed the presence of our Public Safety counterpart, the City of Pewaukee Fire Department.






CALLS FOR SERVICE / CITATIONS HISTORY


■ Calls for Service ■ Citations Issued






