# 2 Registration Information

## Three ways to register

### 1. Mail-In Registration

Fill out the registration form. (Feel free to copy)  
 Identify class ID CODE as it is noted in the guide.  
 Mail-in registration begins August 13 for residents, non-residents may start mailing in forms August 20. Forms received after these dates will be processed on a first-come, first-served basis. Forms received prior to August 13 will be returned.  
 You must pay via cash or check when registering by mail.  
 Confirmation receipts will be mailed or emailed to confirm registration.  
 If a program is full, our office will notify you by phone and return your registration.
