RECYCLING CENTER

Location: Pewaukee City Hall –Lower Level

Hours: Saturdays: 9am to 3pm
Wednesdays: 1pm to 6 pm
(1st week of April thru November)

- ✓ **NO ADMITTANCE** during unscheduled hours or days.
- ✓ **NO SCAVENGING** on site.
- ✓ There is **INCREASED MONITORING** on the site to prevent future contaminations.
- ✓ A **“CITY TAG”** must be **DISPLAYED** on the resident’s vehicle, in plain sight, for the attendant to view And to be admitted. (Tags are obtained at City Hall during regular office hours with a valid Driver’s License and vehicle license plate numbers.)
- ✓ **Materials must be placed in the correct locations at the Recycling Center. Please see attendant for proper placement or questions.**

The City has retained attendants with full authority to turn away persons and unauthorized materials.

Instructions for Yard Waste



Garlic Mustard Weed

Invasive Weeds
Not in Yard Waste.
Must be in a separate plastic bag. Completely sealed. Please see attendant for disposal location.



Canadian Thistle

Leaves and Grass Clippings

If bagged, they must be dumped out of the plastic bag. **NO plastic bags filled with leaves or grass clippings in the composting piles.** A barrel is available for disposal of the used plastic bags. In the past, our loads of yard waste have been rejected at the Composting Facility because they contained plastic bags. **Recyclable PAPER BAGS** that are sold in the local hardware stores are allowed in the composting.

Brush & small trees

Stumps or logs should be 4 inches in diameter and no longer than 6 foot sections.

Garden Debris only. No sod.
